

TOP 10 WAYS
to help clean
YOUR HOME
with Borax

sink cleaner

Mix 1 cup of Borax with 1/4 cup of lemon juice. Using a sponge or cloth, rub the sink with the paste and rinse well with warm water.

patio furniture

Mix 1 tbl Borax & 1 tbl dish detergent in one gallon of hot water. Soak sponge and wipe down.

cast iron cleaner

Mix 1 teaspoon of Borax with 1 teaspoon of salt. Spread on the cookware and scrub.

*soap scum
eraser*

Pour 1 tablespoon of Borax onto a damp sponge and scrub.

laundry softener

Add 1 cup of Borax to your wash load. It will soften hard water, remove soap residue, helps with stains, and neutralizes odors.

*all purpose
cleaner*

Mix 2 tablespoons of Borax and hot water in a spray bottle. Ready to use!

*deodorize the
trash can*

Fill the trash can up with water and 1/2 cup of borax and stir. Let it sit for 30 minutes. Rinse out, dry, and sprinkle with Borax inside the trash can.

*deodorize
the fridge*

Mix 1 tbl of Borax with a quart of warm water. Use a damp cloth dipped in the solution to clean the fridge. Rinse any remnant residue with cold water.

floor cleaner

Mix 1/2 cup of vinegar, 1 squirt of dish detergent, and 1/4 cup of borax in a bucket full of hot water. Rinsing not required.

*window
cleaner*

Mix 2 tbl of Borax with 3 cups of water in a spray bottle. Clean windows. Repeat with equal parts water and vinegar.
